Care & Maintenance	Dust regularily with a clean, soft cloth. Regular cleaning with a soft, damp cloth is all that is needed to keep your leather beautiful. Should you need a more vigorous cleaning, use only a solution of mild soap and water. Blot gently; never rub aggressively. Never use a cleaner with solvents, alcohol, or wax. Should you use a leather cleaner, always test in a hidden area first.
